

The Unborn Jesus Banner proclaims to the world the Mystery of the Incarnation of Our Lord

Explanation of the banner images:

At the top of the banner, the phrase "The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:14), is the motto of the Unborn Jesus Apostolate.

The Unborn Child Jesus is shown inside a white Host overlying on top of the Womb of His Mother.

Our Lady of Guadalupe, in quiet prayer, adores her Child.

Under Mary are the words "Unborn Jesus."



The image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was chosen above other images of the Blessed Mother because:

- It is the image of an expecting Mother in her third trimester
- The prophet Isaiah spoke of an expecting Virgin as the sign of the Emanuel (Isaiah 7:10-15)
- The image is the description of the woman with child from the Book of Revelations, Chapter 12 (Rev 12:1-2)
- Our Lady of Guadalupe is the patroness of the unborn
- The Unborn Baby cannot be separated from His Mother

Assemble your own Unborn Jesus Banner (3' x 5')

Follow these steps:

1. Get you banner printed on vinyl at any copy center
 - Use the large TIF file contained on the CD titled Unborn Jesus Banner
 - Ask for two extra inches of blank material at the top and bottom edges
 - Ask for 6 even spread riveted perforations at both top and bottom edges.
2. Obtain the following materials:
(Home Depot has all these materials)
 - About 6 feet of 1 inch diameter plastic pipe (pvc pipe)
 - 12 Double sided Velcro straps
 - A 6 foot tall 1 3/8 ~ 1.5 inch diameter wooden pole (closet pole)
 - A heavy garden base
 - 4 plastic caps for 1 inch diameter pipe
 - 1 plastic cylindrical joint for 1.5 inch diameter pipe
 - 1 plastic "T" joint for 1 inch diameter pipe
 - 2 shower curtain rings
1. Assemble the banner (see next page)
